Demolition Derby Rules

1. Driver may enter more than one car. --- ONLY CARS --- Any American make sedan or station wagon can be run. **NO** 1973 or older Imperials or Imperial sub-frames/frames, 4x4s, ambulances, trucks, limousines, etc., are not permitted.
2. Driver must use seat belts, shoulder harness, and crash helmet (face shield optional in helmet).
3. Cars can remain stock. No reinforcement permitted, except roll bar, which may be located over the driver's seat and a bar across left door which must not extend over 8 inches beyond door opening (Optional). No spring blocks, risers, or shackle adjustment. Do not remove the firewall.
4. Cars must be equipped with windshields as originally installed, unless a full face shield is worn, rear window optional. All other plastic and glass must be removed.
5. All doors must be closed and welded or secured with chains.
6. Rear seat must be removed. Trunk can be welded shut or securely fastened.
7. Gas tank must be removed from stock position and secured inside the car by whatever means to prevent any movement. An auxiliary gas tank may be substituted (such as boat gas tank) as long as it is tightly secured to the vehicle, and this will be closely checked. A maximum of five (5) gallons of gas will be allowed in each heat run.
8. Battery may be relocated. If moved to drivers compartment, it must be secured and covered by a commercial type battery cover (boat box). Only one battery permitted. Covering distributor, removing fan, or hand throttle permitted.
9. Hood must have twelve (12) inch hole cut over carburetor in case of fire. Hood must be where it can be opened for inspection by Judges before event. Hood must then be securely fastened down. Excessive reinforcement of grill and hood will not be allowed by the fastening material.
10. No studded tires.
11. Each car must have large number painted on each front door and on top. In case of duplicate numbers, Judges will assign numbers.
12. Sponsors name may be printed on car, anywhere except on doors with numbers. No obscene or off-color printing permitted.
13. All cars must be checked in pit area at Fairgrounds. There will be a MANDATORY DRIVERS meeting. Time to be announced.
14. Bumpers must be in stock position, and will be measured for height at a strong part of bumper 24 maximum height. NO BUMPER HITCHES. No welding or concrete in frame or bumpers.
15. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO HIT DRIVERS DOORS INTENTIONALLY. (This is for Driver Safety).
16. All drivers must be at least 18 years old, and a LICENSED driver.
17. There must be at least four (4) cars in each heat in order for money prizes to be awarded.
18. All heats will be limited to a maximum of fourteen (14) cars. The number of open heats will be limited to four (4). Therefore the FIRST fifty-six (56) cars to enter shall be accepted, and will run in the four open heats.
19. Driver must stay with his/her car from the time of unloading at fairgrounds, until after his/her heat is over and the car is removed from the derby arena. The only exception to this is during the announced "Drivers Meeting". Driver must let pit crew attend last minute duties away from the car.
20. All body seems can be welded. Pre denting to the trunk is allowed.
21. No alcohol in the pits. If anyone is caught with alcohol, they will be disqualified, this includes their pit crew.
22. Judges decisions are FINAL!

**NOTICE: ALL CARS MUST BE REMOVED FROM FAIRGROUNDS FOLLOWING EVENT. NO EXCEPTION.
Any car not removed will become the property of the Lincoln County Fair.**
