Feeder Calf Show

Wednesday, September 16- 3:00 P.M.

1. Exhibitors: no residency requirement (open show)
2. Limit of three (3) entries per exhibitor with a maximum of two (2) premiums paid per exhibitor.
3. One (1) steer or one (1) heifer of any recognized beef breed or combination of beef cross breeds shall constitute one entry.
4. All calves must be bred by exhibitor.
5. An entry fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per entry will be charged at the time of weigh in.
6. Calves must be merchandisable feeders, free of disease, no evidence of late castration, and all castration wounds must be healed. Dehorning not required, but if dehorned wounds must be healed.
7. Each calf must be ear tagged with an easily readable plastic tag.
8. There will be two (2) classes of steers and two (2) classes of feeder heifers.
9. The two (2) steer classes will be determined by weight with steers having to weigh between 450 and 800 pounds (ie: with ten (10) entries the lightest five (5) entries will be Class I and the five (5) heaviest entries will be Class II.
10. The two heifer classes will be determined by weight with heifers having to weigh a minimum of 400 pounds and a maximum of 750 pounds. The lightest heifers will be in Class III and the heaviest in Class IV.
11. Calves will show loose in pen - no halter.
12. Premiums per class are: First - \$50; Second - \$25; Third - \$15. Trophies to Grand Champion and Reserve Champion (class winners in Class I, II, III and IV will show for Grand Champion).
13. All entries must be in pens and ready for show at 12:00 (noon) on the day of the show.
14. Judging will be at 3:00 P.M.
15. Cattle must be weighed at one of the livestock auction barns prior to bringing cattle to the fair.
16. No pre-registration required.
17. Health papers required on all feeder calves and commercial heifers.
