4-H & FFA Swine Show

- Rules -

1. 4-H & FFA members are required to have been enrolled in the fourth grade on January 1 of the current calendar year in order to be eligible to exhibit their swine in the junior swine show, and will become ineligible at the end of the calendar year following their graduation from high school or at the end of the calendar year following their 20th birthday, whichever comes first. The exhibitors shall be under the supervision of an Extension Agent, or a teacher of Vocational Agriculture and shall be required to comply with all rules of the show.
2. Animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name 30 days or more preceding opening date of this show.
3. All animals must be exhibited by the registered owner and no one will be allowed to assist the exhibitor in the ring unless requested by the judges or the show superintendents.
4. All entries must be on the grounds by 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, during fair week and remain until 9:00 P.M. or completion of the entire show.
5. Adults may assist 4-H & FFA in Boar Classes.
