Judging Procedure

*Garments must be constructed by the contestant with the exception of Lot 1. All garments in the outfit must be sewn by the 4-H member. This does not include accessories.

*Appropriate construction methods should be used for member's age and skill level.

*Judging will be on a grade-level basis with consideration given to the following points:

(The Clover Collection Score Sheet will be used).

a. Appearance of Model (20 points)

b. Outfit on model (40 points)

c. Construction as it affects appearance (30 points)

d. Knowledge of subject matter (10 points)

4-H members should be dressed and in place by 10:45 AM at the 4-H Building stage! Prizes will be as

Divisions

Judging will be by grade level cluster. Remember that all garments in the outfit must be constructed by the 4-H member, with the exception of Lot 1.

Lot 1-Beginning Sewing (Elastic Waist Garment) Grades 4 - 5 (1 - 2 years sewing experience)

Lot 2-Beginning Sewing Grades 6 - 12 (1 - 2 years sewing experience)

Lot 3-Active Sportswear Grades 4-5

Lot 4-School Wear Grades 4 - 5

Lot 5-Best Wear Grades 4 - 5

Lot 6-Active Sportswear Grades 6-8

Lot 7-School Wear Grades 6 - 8

Lot 8-Best Wear Grades 6 - 8

Lot 9-Active Sportswear Grades 9-12

Lot 10-School Wear Grades 9 - 12

Lot 11-Best Wear/Formal Wear Grades 9 - 12

4-H building stage at 11 a.m.

1. All entrants must lead a lambl. which has been fitted, conditioned and trained to show at halter.
2. Animal does not have to be owned by entrant and can be a ewe or wether.
3. Entrant must wear a garment made of wool or a high percentage (50% or greater) wool blend. Garment does not have to be constructed by entrant.
4. Divisions (grade on January 1, last year):

Pee-Wee (up to 4th grade) **Explorer** - 4th Grade - **Junior** - 5th - **Jr. High** - 6th - 8th Grades - **Senior Level I** - 9th - 10th Grades - **Senior Level II** - 11th - 12th Grades - **Adult** Division

5. Premiums as follows: 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$30, 3rd - \$20, All other \$10.

6. The following standards will be used when judging the classes: A. Entrant's garment suitable and practical for entrant - 40% B. Poise and appearance - 30% C. Control and presentation of sheep - 30%

7. 4-H and FFA competition is open to any member from any location.

The objectives of the contest are:

1. To present a class of sheep in the most attractive manner.
2. To give spectators an opportunity to view young people modeling wool garments while leading the wool producer and
3. To provide an opportunity for young people to develop poise.
