- Rules -

1. An entry fee of \$5.00 per animal will be charged. **No late entries.** All entries must be postmarked no later than registration deadline on entry form. **Only two breeds per exhibitor.**
2. September 1 is to be used as the base date for computing ages of sheep. The lambs must have all lamb teeth.
3. All sheep exhibited must be registered in the flock books of their respective breeds and bear tattoos or ear tags of their respective American Association before entering the ring.
4. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and meet the requirements of the scrapie program.
5. Exhibitors are limited to two entries in each individual class and to one entry in any group class.
6. All entries must be on the grounds by 11:00 on Friday, during Fair week, and may leave **after show is completed.**
7. Open show champions and reserve champions will pay \$15 and \$10 respectively rather than plaques; Youth show champions and reserve champions will receive plaques only.
8. **Youth member's competition is open to members from any location.**
9. Animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name 30 days or more preceding opening date of this show.
10. All animals must be exhibited by the owner, and no one will be allowed to assist the exhibitor in the ring unless requested by the judges or show superintendent. Youth participating must be old enough to show own animal.
11. Placing money will be as follows for each class of ewes and rams per age classification: Open Show \$23 \$18 \$10 \$8 \$6
Youth: \$23 \$18 \$10 \$8 \$6 All other entries to receive \$5
12. Exhibitors arriving later than 11:00 A.M. from another show must provide note from that show's superintendent verifying time the show concluded.
13. **Due to limited barn space, the first 350 entries will be accepted.**
14. Youth classes will include only Ewe classes, NO RAMS.

Showmanship will begin at 4:00 P.M.

Class 1. Beginner (Ages: 4th grade & Under)

Class 2. Junior (5-6 grades, Junior High (7-8 grades), Senior (9-12 grades)

RAM CLASSES FOR OPEN SHOW ONLY.

Class 3. Senior Ram Lamb (Born September 1, to December 31, last year)

Class 4. Early Junior Ram Lamb (Born January 1 to February 15, this year)

Class 5. Late Junior Ram Lamb (Born February 16 to April 30, this year)

Class 6. Pair of Ram Lambs (Classes 3,4 & 5)

Class 7. Champion Ram (Open Show - \$15;

Reserve Champion Ram (Open Show - \$10)

Class 9 .Sr. Yearling Ewes (Born September 1, two years ago to February 15 last year).

Class 10. Jr. Yearling Class (Born February 16 last year to August 31, last year)

Class 11. Pair of Yearling Ewes

Class 12. Senior Ewe Lambs (Born September 1 to December 31, last year)

Class 13. Early Junior Ewe Lambs (Born January 1 to January 31, this year)

Class 14. Intermediate Junior Ewe Lambs (Born February 1 to February 28, this year)

Class 15. Late Junior Ewe Lambs (Born March 1 to April 30, this year)

Class 16. Pair of Ewe Lambs

Class 17. Champion Ewe (Open Show - \$15; Youth Show - plaque only)

Reserve Champion Ewe (Open Show - \$10; Youth Show - plaque only)

Class 18. Pen of Four (1 ram - 3 ewes) **Open show only.**

Class 19. Tennessee Bred by Exhibitor (Youth show only).

One entry per exhibitor per breed. For ewes only. Champion - Plaque.

Class 21. Herdsman Award - \$15, \$12 (1 st & 2nd place only)

*An exception to the above classifications of sheep may be made when an exhibitor wishes to enter a younger animal in the next older age classification. In no case will an older animal be entered in a younger age classification than its birthday would permit.
